## EDGEWATER TOWN ANNUAL MEETING

The Annual Meeting of the Town of Edgewater will be held starting at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2008 at the Edgewater Town Hall, 1470N Wooddale Road. The 2007 Audit Report will be given by Dan Thole, CP A, and the electors will vote to approve the audit.

The Town Board meeting will immediately follow the Annual Meeting. Two Plan Commission members will be nominated by the CIL, approved by the Board and sworn into office for three year terms. Our Plan Commission consists of five members serving staggered terms, plus one alternative.

## General Spring Election is April 1

Wisconsin's primary election determines which candidates' names will be on the November election ballot. If you need an absentee ballot for this April 1 election, they will be available from the town Clerk by March 11<sup>th</sup>; the last day for electors to request absentee ballots by mail is March 27<sup>th</sup>, and in person is May 31<sup>st</sup>. Our polling place is the Town Hall, 1470N Wooddale Road. Polling hours will be from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

The Town of Edgewater has successfully used the electronic voting equipment mandated by HAVA in 2002: "people with a wide range of disabilities must vote privately and independently." The purchase and use of voting equipment

was a requirement made by the State and U.S. governments beginning with the fall 2006 elections.

We received \$6,000 reimbursement from the Wisconsin State Elections Board for the purchase of our voting system which was "approved by the State Elections Board for use in Wisconsin" and was purchased collaboratively with all other towns in Sawyer County.
